## Seed Descriptions

**Philly Wild Bird Blend – 20 lb. bag**

Black oil sunflower with millet, peanuts, sunflower chips and striped sunflower.

**Bird's Breakfast – 20 lb. bag**

Black oil sunflower, peanuts, cashews, almonds, pecans & stripe sunflower only  
- no millet.

**Deck & Patio Blend – 20 lb. bag**

No waste, no seed hulls, no mess.  
Sunflower chips, split peanuts, hulled millet.

**Black Oil Sunflower – 25 lb. bag**

The single most preferred food of most birds.

**Safflower – 25 lb. bag**

Cardinals and many other birds like it. Squirrels don't!

**Sunflower Chips– 25 lb. bag**

No seed hulls.

**Cracked Corn – 25 lb. bag**

**Peanut Splits – 5 lb. or 25 lb. bag**

No shells, no mess.

**Fruit and Berry Mix – 5 lb. bag**

A premium mix of seeds, nuts, and  
dried fruits.

**Nyjer – 4 lb., 8 lb., or 25 lb. bag**

Small black seed is especially attractive to Goldfinches.

**Hot Pepper Suet Cake – 12 oz.**

Squirrels don't like the hot pepper.  
Birds can't taste it.

**Peanut Suet Cake – 12 oz.**

Rendered beef suet and roasted peanuts. Attractive to woodpeckers and others.

**Pure Suet Cake – 12 oz.**

Pure Suet. No peanuts, no seeds.
